PREPARING YOUR HOUSE OF WORSHIP

- CLEANING AND DISINFECTION PRACTICES WILL BE IMPLEMENTED, ACCORDING TO CDC GUIDELINES: WWW.CDC.GOV/CORONAVIRUS/2019-NCOV/COMMUNITY/ORGANIZATIONS/CLEANING-DISINFECTION.HTML.
 - SHARED RESOURCES WILL BE SANITIZED AFTER EACH USE, AND ALL HIGH-TRAFFIC/HIGH-TOUCH AREAS (E.G. RESTROOMS, DOORKNOBS, COUNTERS, MICROPHONES, AND SEATS) – WILL BE REGULARLY SANITIZED AFTER EVERY USE; DISINFECTANT SPRAY WILL BE AVAILABLE IN EVERY STALL.
 - THERE WILL BE CONTROLLED POINTS OF ENTRY AND EXIT. CHECK FILTERS AND REMOVE ANY OBSTRUCTION FROM BLOCK VENTS. USE ALLERGY FILTERS, WHICH MUST BE CHANGED MORE FREQUENTLY (CHECK EVERY MONTH).
 - RESTROOMS WILL BE CLEANED AND SANITIZED DAILY. DISPOSABLE PAPER TOWELS WILL BE AVAILABLE.
 - WE WILL MOVE AND LIMIT UNNECESSARY PHYSICAL OBJECTS IN ORDER TO REDUCE POTENTIAL TRANSMISSION OF THE VIRUS.
 - CAREFUL ATTENTION WILL BE GIVEN TO PRESCHOOL AND CHILDREN'S AREAS. WE WILL REMOVE NONESSENTIAL ITEMS TO MINIMIZE HIGH CONTACT SURFACES. SANITIZE SURFACE AREAS BETWEEN USE.
